

Lake Chesterfield Clubhouse Guidelines

The clubhouse may be rented for private parties.

There is a \$25 charge for clubhouse access privileges. Contact 636-458-1070 or LCHOA@LCHOA.ORG to request access form.

1. The clubhouse is a non-smoking facility
2. No swimsuits allowed in the main multi-purpose room.
3. No wet swimsuits allowed in the recreation room.
4. Pool table is limited to persons 16 years or older unless accompanied by a parent.
5. Kitchen facilities are for the use of private parties only, unless authorized by the manager or a trustee.
6. No one under the age of 16 is allowed in the clubhouse unless accompanied by a parent or guardian over the age of 21.
7. Children under the age of 12 are not allowed in the weight room. Must be 12 years old and accompanied by parent or guardian over the age of 21 to use the exercise equipment. Must be 16 years old to use exercise equipment without parent/guardian supervision.
8. Shoes and shirts must be worn at all times during use of the exercise equipment.
9. No food or drink (except water) is allowed in the weight room.
10. For the courtesy of others, please bring a towel and wipe down the equipment after use.
11. Unless the clubhouse is rented for a private party, there is a limit of 6 guests per household in the clubhouse. Guests must always be accompanied by a resident.
12. The clubhouse is not open for recreational or weight room usage when the clubhouse is rented for a private party.
13. Entry to the pool area is not to be gained from the clubhouse at anytime. Exit doors to the pool area are alarmed and no one is allowed exit or entry through these doors.

Failure to abide by clubhouse rules could result in loss of all membership privileges.

General Rules:

1. No skateboards will be permitted on any part of the exercise trail or clubhouse parking lot.
2. No motorized vehicles or horses are allowed on the exercise trail.
3. Any signs posted on common ground or property of the City of Wildwood may be removed and destroyed.

LAKE CHESTERFIELD RULES AND REGULATIONS - LAKES AND POND

WARNING: During low lake level conditions care should be taken around the lake shore and/or lake bottoms.

LAKES AND PONDS

The lakes and pond are for the exclusive use of the residents of Lake Chesterfield and their accompanied guests only.

1. No swimming is allowed in the lakes.
2. No ice skating is allowed on the lakes.
3. Discarding waste material of any kind into the lake is strictly prohibited.
4. No feeding of the waterfowl is allowed. Do not feed the geese. Their droppings are, not only unsightly, but a health hazard. Their numbers will increase until they outnumber us. Geese will attack.
5. No dogs or other pets in the lakes.
6. No swimming pool type rafts/floats or any homemade floating devices will be allowed on the lakes.
7. Vehicles are not to park blocking the boat ramp at any time except when launching a watercraft.

FISHING

1. Fishing is allowed by resident owners and their accompanied guests only.
2. Fish may be harvested using line and rod or pole only. No trotlines, jug fishing, or net fishing is allowed.
3. Any limits on size or quantity of fish taken from the lakes will be available through the management office.

BOATING

1. Boating on the lakes and pond is allowed from ½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset.
2. Boat operators must follow all Missouri Public Waterway and U. S. Coast Guard regulations.
3. All watercraft must be registered for use on the Lake Chesterfield lakes and pond. Registration for property owners is available through the management office. The registration identification must be displayed when the craft is in use on any of the lakes or pond.
4. All watercraft, including sailboats, must be 18 feet or less.
5. No swimming pool type rafts/floats or any homemade floating devices will be allowed on the lakes.
6. No gasoline motors or diesel motors allowed on the lake.
7. Only human, wind and electric powered watercraft are allowed on the lakes.
8. Only boats with electric trolling motors, with a thrust of 14 pounds maximum, will be allowed on the lake.
9. Vehicles are not to park blocking the boat ramp at any time except when launching a watercraft.
10. No boat is to be docked overnight, whether at the marina dock or elsewhere.

LAKE CHESTERFIELD POOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Admission to the pool is limited to members of Lake Chesterfield Homeowners Association in good standing upon presentation of membership pass.
2. Guest fees will be \$.50 cents for ages 9 and under; \$1.00 for ages 10 and older daily.
3. No glass inside the pool area.
4. Limit of six guests per family allowed.
5. Guests may be limited, barred or removed if the Pool Manager, Trustee or On Site Manager deems the pool to be too crowded.
6. No children under 10 years of age will be permitted in the pool area unless accompanied by a resident 16 years or older.
7. Children of diaper age must wear rubber pants in addition to any diaper they are wearing, or diapers specifically made for swimming.
8. No child will be permitted in the deep water section of the pool unless they have demonstrated their ability to swim one width of the pool and to tread water for AT LEAST 30 seconds, to the satisfaction of the lifeguards on duty.
9. Running and rough play is prohibited at all times. The lifeguard at his/her discretion has the authority to enforce a "time out" policy to anyone not conducting themselves in a proper manner. The guard also has the authority to ask any person(s) to leave the pool area for improper conduct and/or language. It is the responsibility of all club members to know the club rules and explain them to their children.
10. Admission to the pool is refused to all persons having a contagious or infectious condition.
11. No diving in shallow water less than 5 feet.
12. No piggyback games in the pool or flips off the side of the pool will be allowed.
13. Air mattresses, swim fins, and tubes shall be allowed, but limited to times when the lifeguard feels their use will not interfere with other swimmers use of the pool.
14. Only swimming apparel will be allowed, no shorts or cut-offs permitted.
15. No Frisbees, nerf balls, or any balls that would be considered unsafe by the lifeguard allowed.
16. No oily suntan lotion will be permitted, due to the damage it does to the filters. Other lotions must be in plastic bags.
17. No dogs or other pets will be permitted in the pool area.
18. Unnecessary conversation with or annoying a lifeguard, while on duty will not be permitted.
19. The adult pool is limited to persons 18 years or older.
20. Food and tobacco is limited to tables and perimeter areas.
21. All waste material must be placed in the proper disposal containers at all times.
22. Damage to club property, including trees, shrubs and flowers will not be permitted and any member that causes such damage will be held personally responsible.
23. The pool may be closed for maintenance purposes, health condition, weather or any reason deemed sufficient by the pool manager.
24. Violation of the rules and regulations will result in expulsion from the pool. Three expulsions during a single pool season will result in revoking your pass until the next board meeting. At the meeting, your pool pass may or may not be revoked for the remainder of the season.
25. All rules are subject to change without prior notice if conditions so require.
26. Chairs and lounges are primarily for use by adults. Children should relinquish them when the pool and/or deck begin to fill.
27. All members shall drive slowly and carefully on the driveway and approaches within the parking areas.
28. The pool may be rented for personal parties after normal operating hours. (See Site Manager for details)

ENTRANCE THRU MAIN POOL GATE ONLY.

***A current membership card is required.**

***Guests must always be accompanied by a resident.**

Lake Chesterfield Tennis Rules

1. Tennis courts are only for the use of members of the Lake Chesterfield Homeowners Association and their accompanied guests.
2. Tennis courts close at 11:00 P.M.
3. Courts are to be used exclusively for playing tennis and players must wear tennis shoes.
4. Tennis only; no other activities (including , but not limited to, basketball, rollerblading, soccer, bicycling, skateboarding, etc.) are permitted
5. Tennis courts are available on a first come, first serve basis.
6. Play is limited to one hour if others are waiting.
7. You must be 12 years old to use the tennis courts without a parent or guardian, over the age of 21.
8. Residents of any age may use the tennis court when accompanied by parent/guardian.
9. No pets allowed.
10. No glass allowed.
11. Proper tennis etiquette will be observed at all times:
 - Call a let when a ball from the next court interrupts play.
 - Do not walk behind the other court while ball is in play.
 - Show good sportsmanship at all times.
 - Do not protest or question your opponent's calls.
 - Give up the court when your time is up.
 - Foul language or excessive noise is not permitted.
